





Clelian Heights at a Glance

Clelian Heights Inc., also known as Clelian Heights School for Exceptional Children, is a licensed, private, non-profit, educational, and vocational facility for children and adults. Founded in 1961 by the community of Sisters, the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Clelian Heights is dedicated to enabling children and adults with intellectual and

developmental disabilities. including those on the autism spectrum, to function in the world at their own ability level as contributing and valuable members of society.

Serving Southwestern PA individuals in 9 counties and 20 school districts. Clelian Heights provides a continuum of care from age 5 through adulthood for more than 140 students and adults. The Commonwealth of PA Departments of Human Services and Education license Clelian Heights programs. Services are offered to all. without discrimination on the basis of race, religion, sex, or national origin.

Care begins with a special academic environment in the program at age 5 through



21. It incorporates a transition-to-work program in adolescence and moves on to community employment or employment at the Clelian Center where services such as mail operations. packaging, small parts assembly, and commercial laundry are contracted with local businesses.


The Clelian Center also produces Captain and Sandy Gourmet Dog Treats, and a variety of Scentsational Soaps made to order.

The facilities have large well-equipped classrooms including those for home economics, art, music, job development, occupational and physical therapy and speech pathology. There is a sensory room, a computer room, a dining and meeting rooms, a library, a chapel, an indoor playground, a recreation center with a fitness area, gym, and therapy pool.

There is an outdoor pool and a large playground with a pavilion and ball field, an inner court area with a sand circle, a bike garage and a biking/walking path, a lunch patio and an

amphitheater for outdoor activities.

The Clelian Center has a licensed vocational training workshop, bussing and food service training areas. a soap making room, greenhouse, dog biscuit



Clelian Heights offers an academic and transition-towork program, adult vocational and personal skills programs, an extended school year program, and a residential option for women on its campus.

There is a team of over 140 dedicated teachers, aides, therapists, supervisors, job coaches, workshop and resident staff, nursing, administrative, and support staff that daily makes it all possible.
