Transition to Work Program

Clelian Heights School Transition to Work Program, provides hands on job training experiences both on and off campus for students ages 14+. Students can work on campus in our dining room, kitchen/ dishwasher area, Clelian Cafe, garden/greenhouse plus many other jobs. They also shop weekly at Walmart and SAM's Club for needed items for The Clelian Cafe. In the community, students visit a variety of locations! The following businesses provide job training opportunities for our students- Horseman's Hide Away Horse Barn, Intervala, Hempfield Municipal Garage Car Wash, Caritas Christi, Westmoreland County Meals on Wheels, Westmoreland County Food Bank, Chick Fil A, Auntie Anne's Pretzels, Thriftique, Hempfield Park, Greensburg and Delmont Libraries, Peinetti's Bakery, Cornerstone Ministries, St. Emma's Retreat House and Christ Church. We are so grateful to these businesses!





Intervala, LLC is partnering with the Clelian Heights Transition to Work program, providing students with community based work training experiences. Intervala, LLC, located outside of Mount Pleasant, PA is a full service manufacturer of high performance printed circuit board assemblies & cable harness assemblies. Clelian students are required to wear a static resistant coat and shoe straps while at work in order to complete their various job tasks. This is a fantastic partnership and so beneficial for our students!





Transition to Work students, get the opportunity to "work" in the Clelian Heights kitchen, running the industrial dishwasher, on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons! Students are responsible on Tuesday's for cleaning the Clelian Cafe delivery bins, water pitchers and Keurig catch trays. Wednesdays, students clean the lunch trays. Students learn all the required steps to run the dishwasher, correct procedures and regulations in a school kitchen and finish by cleaning their work space!





The Clelian Cafe!! A student run cafe that offers snacks, microwavable lunch items, coffee, tea, hot chocolate and specialty coffee drinks. Students check order forms, complete money transactions, fill orders and assist with making the drinks. Then, students deliver the orders!





Chick Fil A -Westmoreland Mall! Transition to Work Students work every Wednesday morning at the mall location. Job duties include cleaning, restocking the condiments and filling the kids bags with necessary items. Students who work at Chick Fil A all receive a name tag to wear! The Westmoreland Mall Chick Fil A has been an excellent partner with our Transition Program! They have provided our students such a positive experience working in the restaurant, making them feel a valued member of their team!
